SPECIFIC REGULATIONS

Article 1: Organization

The 112 edition of Fyen Rundt is organized by Cykling Odense, Thorvalds vænge 9, 5200 Odense V, Denmark, under the regulations of the International Cycling Union. It is to be held on the 14th Of May 2023 - starting at 11.00.

Article 2: Type of event

The event, ME 1.2 is open to athletes of categories Men Elite and Men Under 23.

The event is entered on the UCI Europe Tour calendar and is registered as a class 2 event. In conformity with the UCI rules, points are awarded as follows: 40 - 30 - 25 - 20 - 15 - 10 - 5 - 3 - 3 - 3 for the UCI ranking.

Article 3: Participation

As per article 2.1.005 of the UCI regulations, the event is open to the following teams:

- UCI professional continental teams of the country
- UCI foreign professional continental teams (max. 2)
- UCI Cyclo Cross professional teams
- UCI continental teams
- National teams
- Regional and club teams

Teams must be formed of minimum 4 and maximum 6 riders.

Article 4: Race Headquarter

Team representatives are requested to confirm their starters, license checkup, and collect their start numbers at the race headquarter which will be at the same place as GP Herning on the 12th of May at 17.00 to 18.45 hrs. Located at the following address: Hotel Eyde, Mindegade 1, 7400 Herning

Sunday the race headquarter will be in Middelfart Sparekasse, Havnegade 21, 5500 Middelfart, and will be open Sunday the 14th Of May from 08.30 to 10.00, and after finish for 1 ½ hour. Radios and chips must be handed in here.

The team managers meeting, organized in accordance with article 1.2.087 of the UCI regulations, in the presence of the Members of the Commissaries' Panel, is scheduled for the 12th Of May, starting 19.00 at Hotel Eyde, Mindegade 1, 7400 Herning.

Article 5: Program

Friday

17.00 – 18.45: Licens checkup and number collection in Herning. 19.00: Team managers meeting.

Sunday

09.00-09.30: Briefing security team

09.45-10.50: Signing on and presentation at the podium at the start

11.00: Neutral start. (3,0 km)

11.08: Real start at km. 0 - no stop

Article 6: Radio-tour

Race information will be broadcast on the following frequency: 165.300 MHz.

Article 7: Neutral technical support

The neutral support is taken care of by means of 3 service cars.

Article 8: Finishing time limits

Any rider finishing in a time exceeding that of the winner by more than 8% shall not be placed. The time limit may, in exceptional circumstances, be increased by the Commissaires Panel in agreement with the organizer.

Article 9: Classifications

The following classification will be issued: individual To be placed, riders must fulfill the race.

Article 10: Prizes

The following prizes are awarded: The first 20 riders in individual classification

A grand total of € 6.050 will be awarded in prize money at the event.

Article 11: Antidoping

The UCI antidoping regulations are entirely applicable to the event. The antidoping tests will take place in Middelfart Sparekasse – near the start and finish area.

Moreover, and in conformity with the law of Denmark, The Danish antidoping legislation (ADD) is applicable in addition to the UCI antidoping regulations.

Article 12: Award ceremony

In accordance with article 1.2.112 of the UCI rules, the following riders must attend the official awards ceremony: no. 1, no. 2 and no. 3

The winding rider shall present themselves at the podium area right after crossing the finish line.

Article 13: Penalties

The UCI penalty scale is the only one applicable.




